# Sand Dune Park - 1st Community Outreach Meeting

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## Outreach Meeting Summary NO.1

- Attendees were introduced to the project on site
- Community members had the opportunity to provide input via a dotmocracy exercise
- Residents had the opportunity to give feedback through a virtual survey

## Survey Summary NO.1

- Community would like an upgraded playground to include elements for older kids
- More lighting throughout the park was requested
- An accessible and modernized office/ restroom was a significant comment
- Protection of the existing Mulberry trees is essential
- Residents requested an outdoor educational programming space
- New fencing was proposed

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## Outreach Meeting Summary NO.2

- Community members had the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback on two concepts
- Boards allowed residents to provide direct comments on playground equipment and designs

## Community Feedback from Meeting Summary NO.2

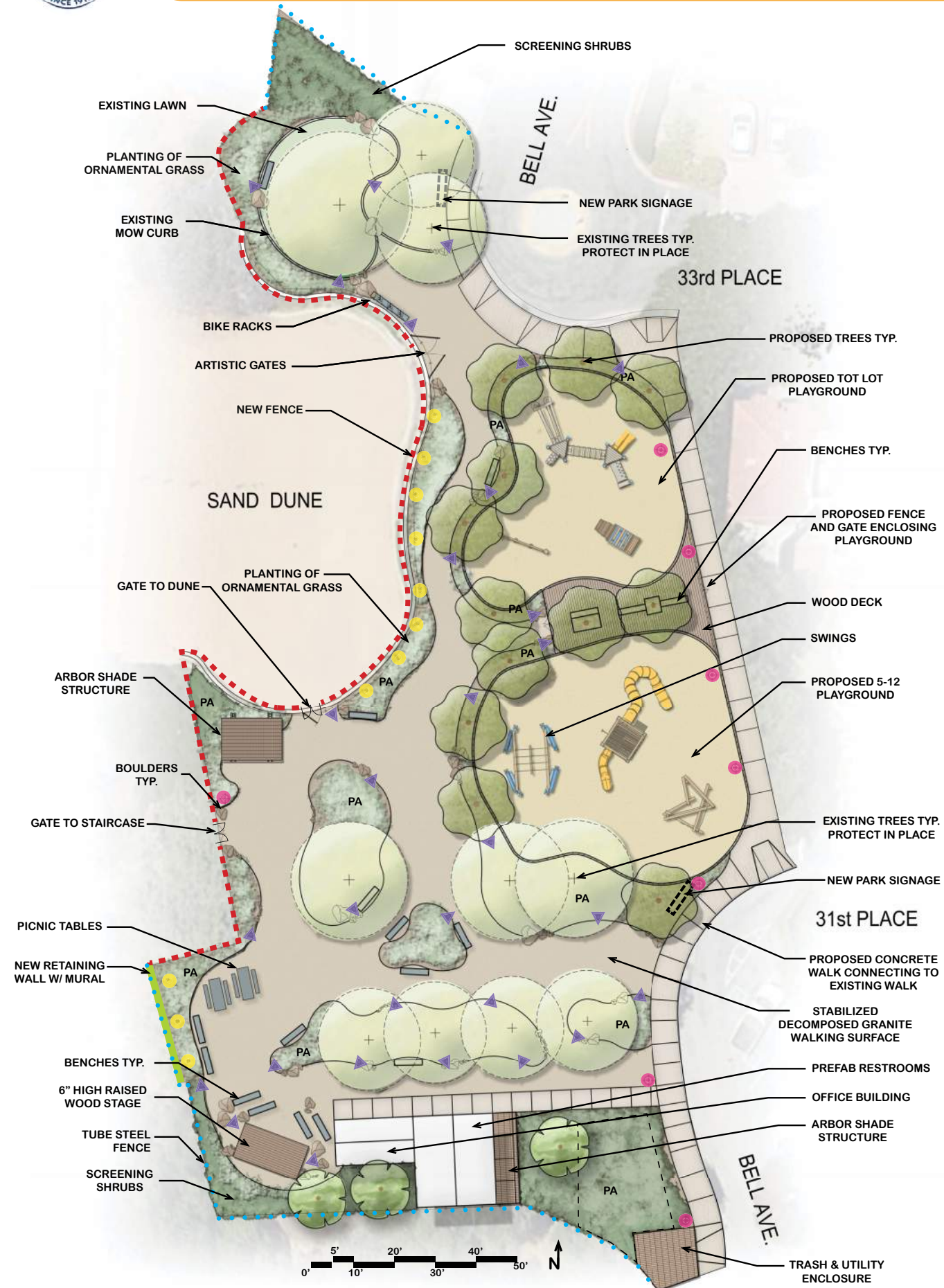
- Concept two was preferred by the community

- New lighting and upgraded fences were key comments



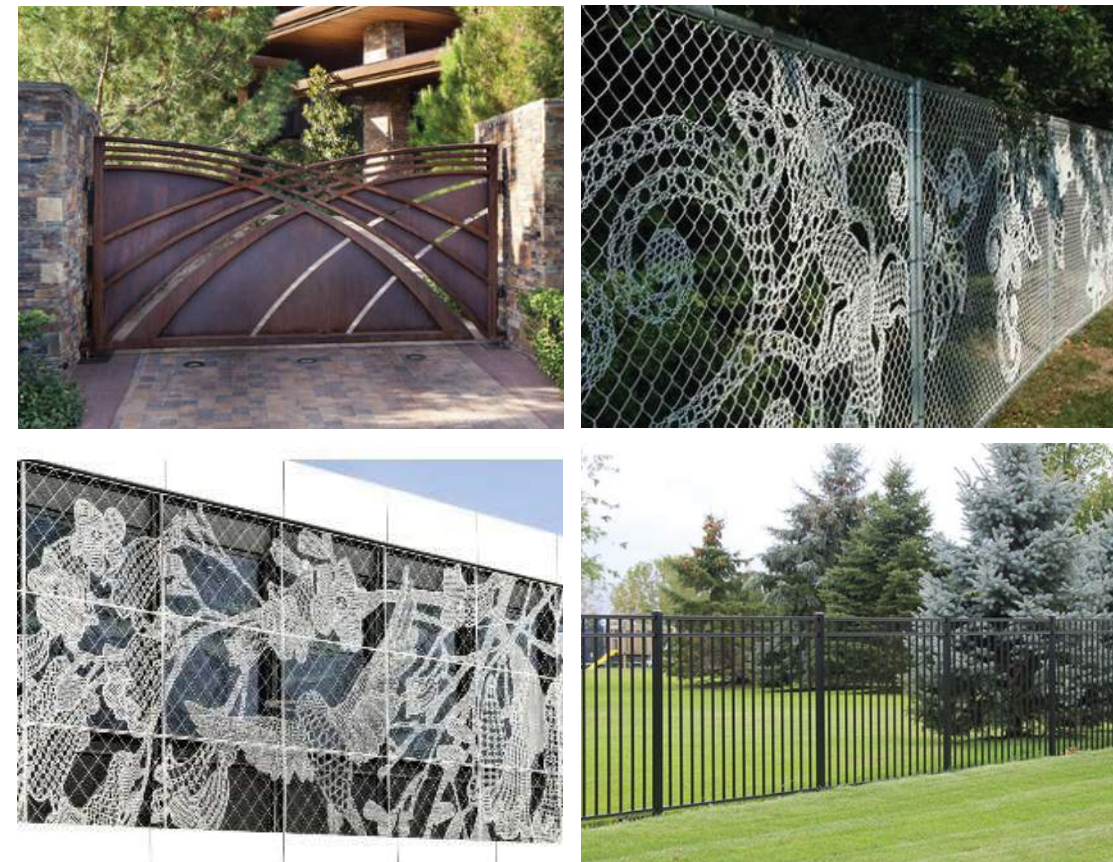

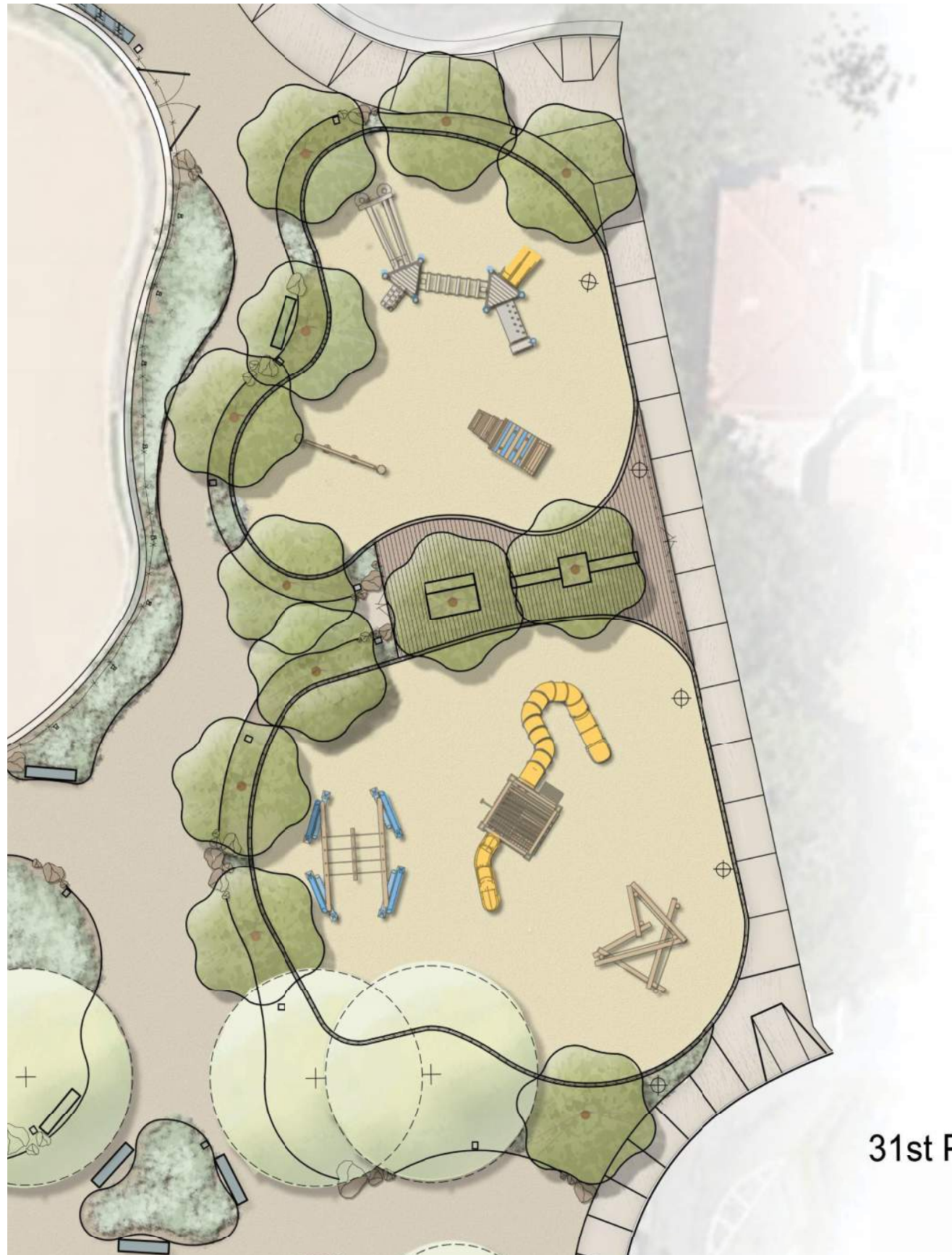

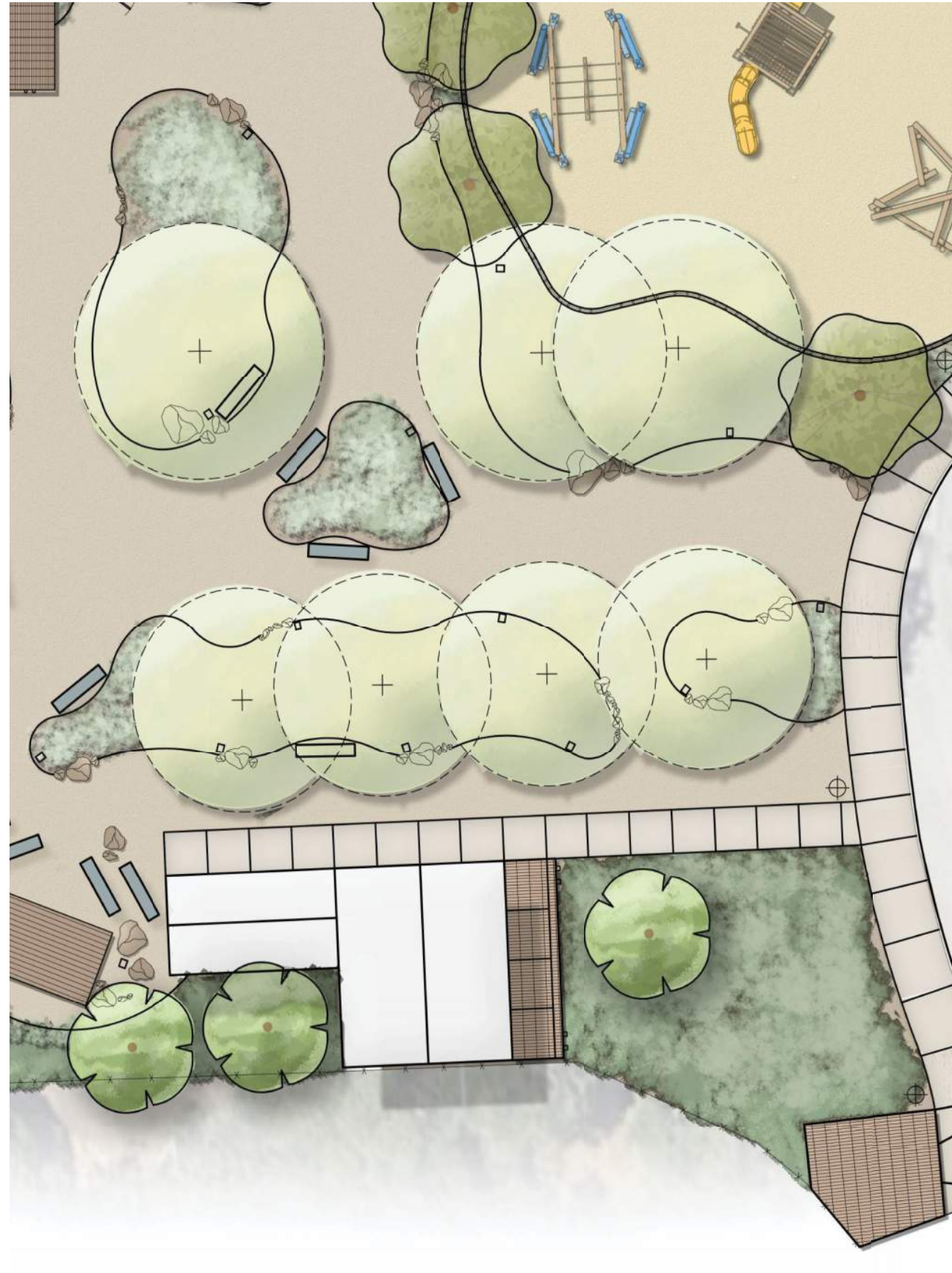
