

A parking pad is a paved surface* in the public right-of-way that is accessible by a vehicle from the roadway and does not lead to a garage or parking space on private property.

APPLICABLE CODES

CVC 530. A "roadway" is that portion of a highway improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel.

Municipal Codes

09.72.015 - Development of street right-of-way for public uses.


14.01.110 - Parkway. That portion of a public right of way other than a roadway or sidewalk.

14.36.030 - Stopping or standing in parkways prohibited. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within any parkway.

14.40.120 - Driving and parking on private property.

A. No person shall park, stand or drive any vehicle on any private property or driveway without the express implied consent of the owner or person in lawful possession of each driveway or property.

B. When signs authorized by the provisions of this chapter are in place, giving notice thereof, no person shall park, stand or drive any vehicle contrary to the directions or provisions of such signs.
