CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC MEETING COURTESY NOTICE

Commercial and Transient Uses in Residential Zones

As a courtesy to persons who have registered with the Manhattan Beach Finance Department to provide short-term vacation rentals and those who reside within 100 feet of these registered properties, please take notice that on June 2, 2015, the City Council introduced Ordinance Nos. 15-0009 and 15-0010 to prohibit single family and multiple-family transient uses (defined as short-term rentals of 29 days or less). The City Council will consider adoption of these Ordinances at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 16, 2015.

The Ordinances would also authorize the owners of properties that were registered with the Finance Department as of April 30, 2015 to continue the use of these properties for short-term vacation rentals until December 31, 2015.
