

RESOLUTION NO. 15-0066

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING AND SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF HERMOSA BEACH TO IMPLEMENT THE PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY (PCH) AVIATION BOULEVARD MOBILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, for the past several years the City of Hermosa Beach (“HERMOSA”) has been developing a long range plan to implement major improvements to the Pacific Coast Highway corridor and Aviation Boulevard to improve traffic circulation, pedestrian access, bicycle access and transit efficiency;

WHEREAS, the improvements envisioned by HERMOSA would be of significant benefit not only to HERMOSA, but also to the South Bay region and specifically to the City of Manhattan Beach;

WHEREAS, HERMOSA has worked closely with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to develop a workable and reasonable plan of improvements;

WHEREAS, HERMOSA has been actively seeking funding for this ambitious project through the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro Call for Projects 2015) and through the South Bay Cities Council of Governments (SBCCOG Measure R); and

WHEREAS, HERMOSA has requested indications of support for the PCH/Aviation Mobility Improvement Project and for the various funding applications for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. By adoption of this Resolution, the Manhattan Beach City Council (“City Council”) hereby endorses and supports the efforts of HERMOSA to develop and implement the PCH/Aviation Mobility Improvement Project.

SECTION 2. The City Council encourages approval of funding applications for the PCH/Aviation Mobility Project.

SECTION 3. The City Council commits to cooperating with HERMOSA as the PCH/Aviation Mobility Improvement Project is developed and implemented.

SECTION 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to communicate the support of the City for the PCH/Aviation Mobility Improvement Project to the HERMOSA

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
