# **CATALINA CLASSIC SCULPTURE**

- Dec 2018 City Council approved concept for a commemorative sculpture.
- Nov 2021 City Council authorized an MOU to accept and maintain a donated sculpture. Fabrication and installation to be provided at no cost to City.
- Aug 2023 Sculpture was unveiled.
- May 2024 City Council requested that staff determine the cost for the City to complete necessary ADA upgrades.



## **DIRECTION NEEDED**

Staff recommends that the City Council consider the following and provide direction:

- 1. Should the City fund the work necessary to create an ADAcompliant parking space in the Lower Pier Parking Lot?
- 2. If yes, City Council may:
  - a) Appropriate \$30,000 from the CIP fund for the work to be completed in conjunction with the Citywide Concrete Repairs Project; or
  - b) Appropriate \$50,000 from the CIP fund to expedite the work as a stand-alone project.

#### 3. If no, SBBC would have to complete the work.
