

RESOLUTION NO. 25-0124

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY
COUNCIL SETTING FORTH FINES AND PENALTIES FOR
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF
CHAPTER 3.68 (MOBILE VENDING BUSINESS)

RECITALS

A. In 2016, the Manhattan Beach City Council adopted Resolution No. 16-0057 to establish fines and penalties for administrative citations.

B. Periodically, the City Council reviews Resolution No. 16-0057 and amends such fines and penalties.

C. On a number of occasions, the City Council has amended such fines and penalties for particular violations.

D. In connection with the adoption of Ordinance No. 25-0011, which amends Municipal Code Chapter 3.68 relating to mobile vending businesses, the City Council desires to amend fines and penalties for violations of Chapter 3.68.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law including Resolution No. 16-0057 and any amendments thereto, violations of Chapter 3.68, or any subsequently adopted regulation of mobile vending businesses, shall be treated as a misdemeanor punishable by: (1) a fine not exceeding \$500 for the first violation; (2) a fine not exceeding \$750 for the second violation within one year; and (3) a fine not exceeding \$1,000 for each additional violation within one year of the first violation. These administrative citations are subject to the late penalties as provided in Manhattan Beach Municipal Code Section 1.06.080.

SECTION 2. The adoption of this Resolution approves and sets forth a procedure for establishing fines and penalties for administrative citations for violations of Municipal Code Chapter 3.68 relating to mobile vending businesses, and is, therefore, exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8)(A).

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
