

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY
COUNCIL GRANTING A SPECIAL ONE-TIME PERMIT TO
ALLOW ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE USE ON PUBLIC
PROPERTY FOR THE ROUNDHOUSE AQUARIUM AND
OCEANGRAPHIC TEACHING STATION'S CITY COUNCIL
AND STAFF RECOGNITION EVENT

RECITALS

- A. Manhattan Beach Municipal Code Chapter 4.48 prohibits the use of alcohol on all City property without the recommendation of the Chief of Police and approval of the City Council.
- B. The Oceangraphic Teaching Station (OTS) has been operating at the Roundhouse since 1980 and is dedicated to teaching students and visitors about the oceans, marine life and the environment, and provides both son-site classes and outreach classes throughout much of Los Angeles County.
- C. The OTS would like to host a reception at the Roundhouse Aquarium on the Manhattan Beach Pier on June 5, 2025, recognizing the City Council and staff for their continued and long-standing partnership and commitment to the mission of the OTS.

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. After considering the recommendation of the Police Chief, the City Council hereby grants a special permit for the consumption of wine and beer at the recognition reception for the OTS's City Council and staff recognition event to be held at the Roundhouse Aquarium on the Manhattan Beach Pier on June 5, 2025.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.
