The purpose of the installation is not only to celebrate the support of our schools through MBEF and the Endowment, but also to invite viewers to witness the splendor and significance of education in our lives.


The mural depicts a Manhattan Beach child discovering the world. Aided by education, she imagines the layers of earth beneath her, the environment around her, and the future represented in the stars. The art invites the viewer to look more closely and discover the apparent and hidden elements of education, including pressed words about exploration and education.

MBEF Board Approved Adjustments

- Retrack the request for monetary support with exception of annual maintenance including irrigation not to exceed \$2000.
- 2. Increase sections of art tiles by 20% and 10%
- 3. Add inclusive statement for all the community:

 Dedicated to all of the educators, parents,
 students, volunteers, and donors who value
 and support education.
- 4. Distribute the tiles so that all stakeholders are mixed throughout
- 5. Reduce the thickness of the metal art frames to 1"
- 6. Add more sea life imagery to the pelican mural
- 7. Add 8 small textured color tiles among the donor tiles.
