

RESOLUTION NO. 25-0140

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF ORDINANCE NO. 25-0013 TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION TO INCORPORATE AMENDMENTS RELATED TO THE LONG-TERM OUTDOOR DINING PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT INTO THE MANHATTAN BEACH LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to applicable law on November 18, 2025, to consider amendments to Chapter 7.36 (Private Use of the Public Right of Way) and Section A.60.080 (Outdoor facilities) of the Manhattan Beach Local Coastal Program ("MBLCP"). At the December 2, 2025, regular City Council meeting, the City Council approved said amendments through adoption of Ordinance No. 25-0013.

SECTION 2. The proposed amendments to the MBLCP have been reviewed for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act and the City prepared an Initial Study/Negative Declaration. At the November 18, 2025, regular City Council meeting, the City Council adopted the Negative Declaration through adoption of Resolution No. 25-0129.

SECTION 3. The City Council finds that the amendments to the MBLCP are consistent with the MBLCP Land Use Program in that they uphold, and do not hinder, the policies and implementation measures contained within it by furthering the overarching policies pertaining to coastal access, parking, and commercial development that caters to pedestrians.

SECTION 4. The City Council certifies that the subject amendments will be implemented in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act of 1976, as amended, the MBLCP, and State law.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. The City Council hereby directs the City Manager or her designee to submit the MBLCP amendment memorialized in Ordinance No. 25-0013 to the California Coastal Commission for certification in conformance with state law.

SECTION 7. The MBLCP amendment shall take effect upon final certification by the California Coastal Commission.
