- G. GENERAL BUSINESS**

2. Parks and Recreation Commission Work Plan 2026/2027
Director Leyman gave an overview of several summer events (e.g. Juneteenth, Concerts in the Park, Manhattan Beach Grand Prix, Manhattan Beach OpenTennis), including that data shows a 10-12% drop in registrations (trend to be tracked). Acting SRS Sherman provided project updates, notably Marine Avenue Park Pay N Play demolition bid closing, Sand Dune Park construction docs still in progress.

Action items: 1) staff to check and update as needed, committee compositions on staff report (Veterans event, Pay N' Play etc.); 2) Pay N' Play: staff to prepare a timeline for July meeting; 3) Director to share David Voltz Design renderings with the Commission emphasizing that staff is implementing council direction which includes elimination of a bike path element and staff will continue to present updates at 30,60 and 90 day intervals.

Chair Windes called for any public comments on any Business Items. None received.

School District Update: Chair Komatinsky noted: LoveMB has met to discuss suggestions brought by resident Barr at last meeting regarding student e-bikes being stored off-site in public park areas; new superintendent Kim Linz to assume position July 1st.
