Please consider noise levels and time of day noise occurs when evaluating the proposed new facilities associated with Manhattan Beach Country Club.

Our address is 99 Village Circle, in Manhattan Village. We are located at the southeast corner of the Village soccer field.

We hear noise most of the day from the soccer field and the country club pickleball courts, which isn't a problem. Our concern is with time of day.

We hear the sounds from pickleball early in the morning, before 6:30am. Increasing the number of courts on the western portion of the property will potentially increase this offensive noise before 8:00am. I thought these outdoor activities could not begin before 8:00am in Manhattan Beach.

Concerning the proposed outdoor pool, noise in the early morning hours is a concern. If a masters swim program is created, loud whistles which are often used, will create an offensive noise. This occurring before 8:00am is not fair for the local residents .

Please recognize our concerns and force activities which create elevated noise levels to adhere to the rules which have long been established in Manhattan Beach.
