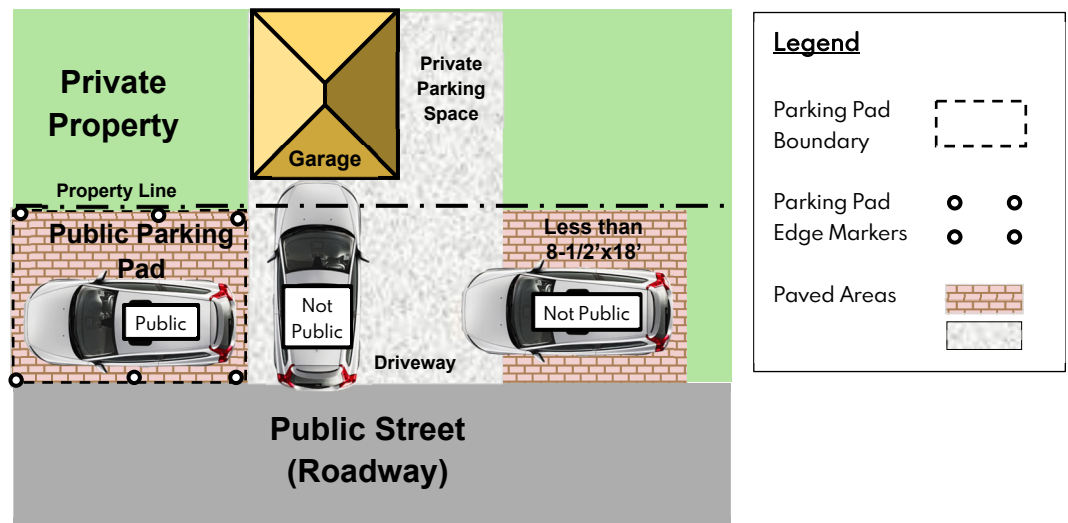
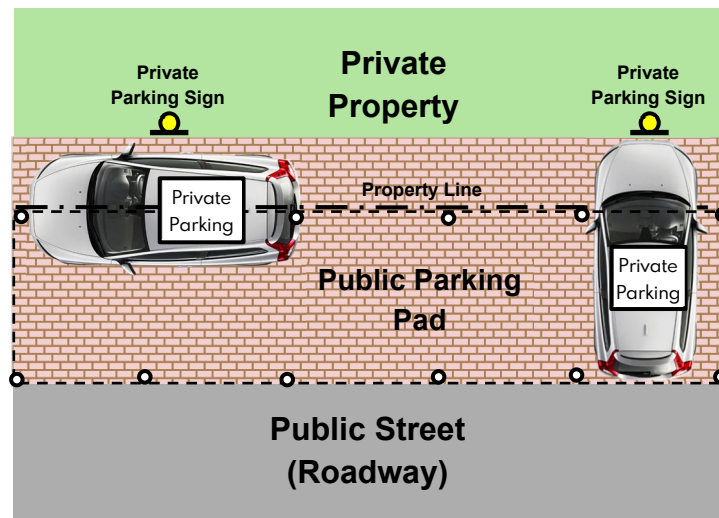


VISUAL GUIDE TO PUBLIC PARKING PADS

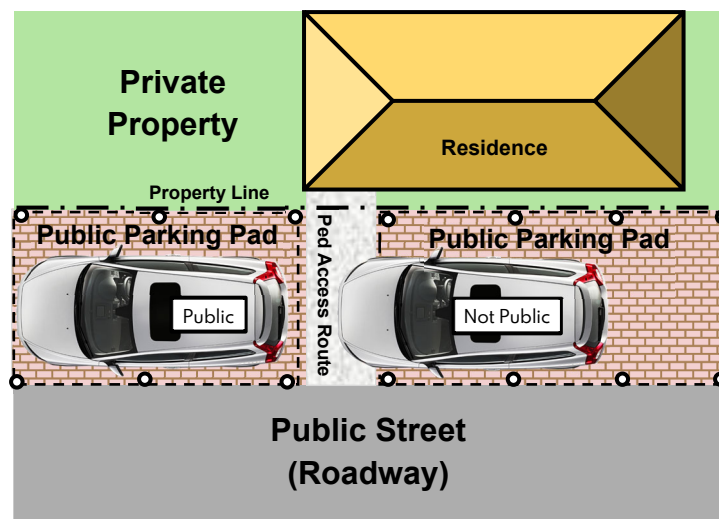
- A. Parking on a driveway without the resident's permission can be enforced if reported to the Police.



- B. Parking on private property can be enforced if private parking signs are properly posted.

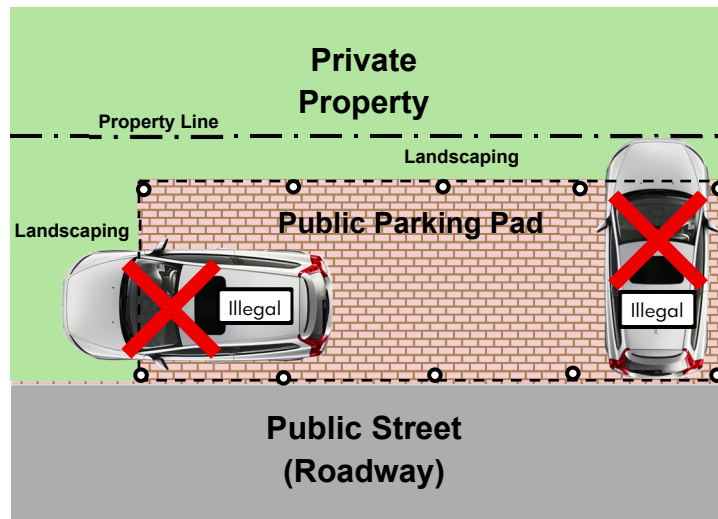


- C. A pedestrian access route (walkway) is not part of a public parking pad.

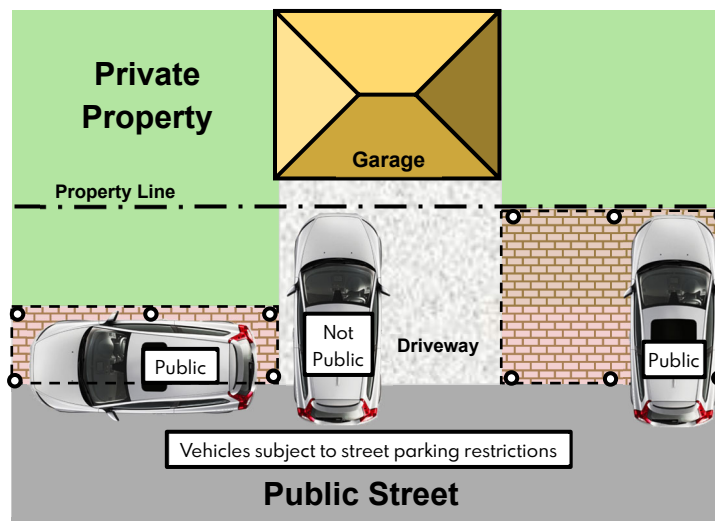

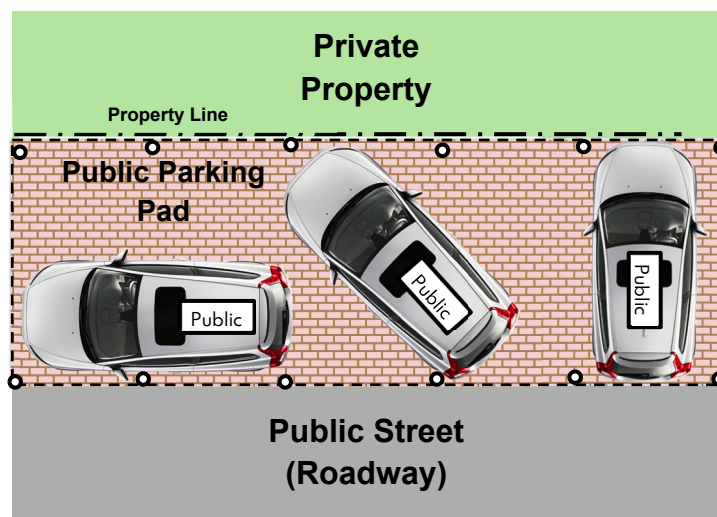
- D. Parking on or over landscaping or unpaved surfaces is prohibited by law.



- E. Any portion of a vehicle parked on or over the roadway is subject to street parking restrictions.



- F. Parking on a public parking pad is allowed parallel, diagonal or perpendicular to street.



Note:

If desired, parking lines can be installed to designate specific parking spaces within parking pad area.
