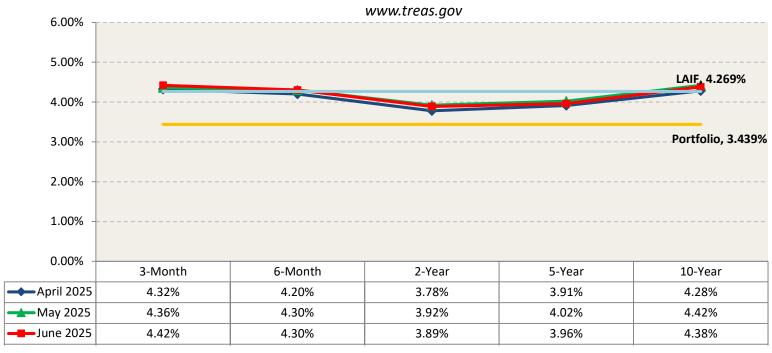

Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition ⁽¹⁾ 5/31/25 \$166.7 billion

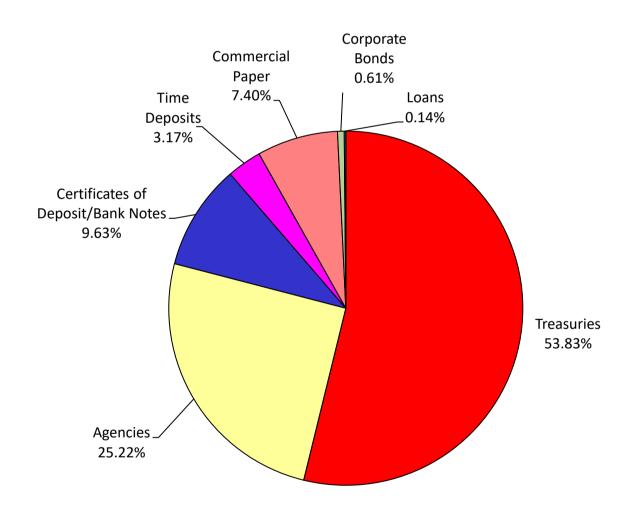
