



Section 3.8.1 of WM Franchise Agreement: "Upon the request of either party, but not more than once every two years, the parties agree to meet and confer, and negotiate in good faith, regarding adjustments to the hauler diversion requirement..."

CITY'S OUTSTANDING CONSIDERATIONS

- Diversion should increase as contract progresses
- 2. Incentives to improve
- 3. Diversion vs. liquidated damages
- 4. Refuse regulations
- 5. Fiscal implications
