

ORDINANCE NO. 18-0013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH
AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.48.090 TO
ALLOW THE CONDITIONAL ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL
PERMITS BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE SERVICE OF
ALCOHOL ON THE BEACH UNDER LIMITED
CIRCUMSTANCES

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby amends Manhattan Beach
Municipal Code Section 4.48.090 to read as follows:

4.48.090 - Limited alcoholic beverage use on public property—Special permit.

“Notwithstanding the other prohibitions of this chapter, after considering the
recommendation of the Chief of Police, the City Council may grant special permits for
the sale or consumption of wine or beer at special functions or activities in a park or
other public place if there is a public benefit to the community. Any such special permit
shall also be subject to the requirements of the California Department of Alcoholic
Beverage Control. For purposes of this section, public place includes the Manhattan
Beach Pier and public beach.”

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of
this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be published within 15 days after its
passage, in accordance with Government Code Section 36933.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and
effect at 12:01 a.m. on the 31st day after its passage. This Ordinance shall
automatically be repealed, without further action by the City Council, on September 1,
2018.
