

RESOLUTION NO. 13-0019

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL
ELIMINATING BOTH THE PAYING AND REPORTING OF THE VALUE
OF MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE MANHATTAN BEACH
MISCELLANEOUS EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY CALIFORNIA
TEAMSTERS LOCAL 911

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2006, the governing body of the City of Manhattan Beach ("City Council") adopted Resolution No. 6067, implementing the provisions of Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) providing for the City to pay and report (effective in the pay period including July 1, 2010) the value of the employer paid member contribution as compensation earnable to the California Public Employees' Retirement System for the employees represented by the California Teamsters, Local 911;

WHEREAS, the City and the Teamsters, Local 911 have negotiated a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) providing that effective March 9, 2013, the members of the Association (not the City) will pay the entire member contribution of seven percent (7%) and that therefore, the member contribution will no longer be reported as compensation earnable to CalPERS;

WHEREAS, the MOU was ratified by the Association and then approved by the City Council at its March 6, 2013 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to repeal Resolution No. 6067.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby eliminates the paying and reporting of the value of employer paid member contributions for the employees represented by the California Teamsters, Local 911.

SECTION 2. The effective date of this Resolution is March 9, 2013.

SECTION 3. Resolution No. 6067 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
