RESOLUTION NO. 15-0021

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL SETTING JULY 7, 2015 AS THE DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER INCREASING SOLID WASTE FEES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH A RECYCLING FOOD WASTE PROGRAM

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Manhattan Beach City Council will be considering increasing its solid waste fees to pay for a food waste recycling program. Article 13D of the California Constitution (otherwise known as Proposition 218) sets forth a procedure for increasing solid waste fees, and requires a noticed, public hearing to provide an opportunity for the public to comment and file written protests to the proposed increase.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The proposed fee schedule would authorize a 3.6% increase for commercial accounts, and a 3% increase for residential customers.

SECTION 3. Based upon the foregoing, the City Council hereby sets July 7, 2015 as the date for a public hearing to consider increasing its solid waste fees and directs staff to give notice of such public hearing in accordance with law.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
