 - 2025 California Green Building Standards Code
 - 2025 California Administrative Code
 - 2025 California Referenced Standards Code





 Pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code Sections 17958.5 and 18941.5, the City is able to amend certain provisions due to the following conditions with limitations due to AB 130:

Climatic

Geological

Topographical



A few notable State Code changes:

Continued increase in safety and energy efficiency requirements

Updates to the battery storage requirements

Updates to the Electric Vehicle Charging Stations requirements

Carried forward MBMC amendments:

- Continue to limit the maximum duration of permits for construction projects
- Continue to clarify when fire sprinklers are required for all structures
- Continue to prohibit the use of wood shakes and wood shingles for new or re-roofs



Carried forward MBMC amendments:

- Continue the requirements for undergrounding or stubbing out for utilities
- Allow non-corrosive plastic building materials in residential construction.
- No local modifications to sustainable building measures to align with the current State Green Building Standards




Some notable MBMC amendments:

- No modifications to the local municipal code amendments adopted by City Council on September 16, 2025
- Removal of the local fire code amendment for the definition of high-rise building of 55 feet to be consistent with State Building Code

lastly...

The majority of the local amendments are carried forward from the previous joint effort by 89 jurisdictions within LA County and update the structural requirements due to potential hazards.
