

We would like all off-street and on-street meters bagged, including the five-hour meters. The only exceptions are the lots jointly controlled by the City and County, located on 26th Street and in El Porto.

We would like the Parking Control Department to cover the meters starting **Saturday, December 1, 2012** and remain covered through **Monday, December 24, 2012**. The bags may be removed on **Wednesday, December 26, 2012**.
