A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE ENTIRE URBAN FOREST MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, at the February 4, 2014 City Council meeting, after staff presented a Citywide street tree inventory as part of the City's 2013 strategic plan, the City Council directed staff to prepare a Street Tree Master Plan, now titled the Urban Forest Master Plan (UFMP) that would create a framework for managing trees in the right of way and on City property;

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the City Council approved the Urban Forest Master Plan but the attachment to the staff report contained only 19 pages instead of the full 66-page document; and

WHEREAS, the entire Urban Forest Master Plan is now being presented to the City Council for approval.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY FINDS, RESOLVES AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby approves the entire 66-page Urban Forest Master Plan.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and the minutes of this meeting shall reflect the presentation of the Report.
