

ORDINANCE NO. 15-0005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH
AMENDING SECTION 14.28.140 REGARDING BICYCLE
PATH HAZARD

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby amends Manhattan Beach Municipal Code Section 14.28.140 (Bicycle path hazard) to read as follows:

“14.28.140 - Bicycle path hazard.

Any Public Safety Officer (Police Officer, Lifeguard or Firefighter) may declare that the number of pedestrians and bicyclists is sufficient so as to create an undue hazard upon the bicycle path. When such conditions exist, a "Walk Only" zone may be created to require the walking of bicycles in the designated area of the bicycle path. Where signs are erected, or flashing lights are present declaring a "Walk Only" zone, it shall be unlawful for anyone to ride a bicycle in the designated area.”

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be published within 15 days after its passage, in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the 31st day after its passage.
