RESOLUTION NO. 17-0131

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-0025 TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION TO INCORPORATE AMENDMENTS TO THE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM (LCP) TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS FOR PROHIBTING ALL COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITY AND ALLOW LIMITED INDOOR CANNABIS CULTIVATION

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AND FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Council conducted a public hearing pursuant to applicable law on October 17, 2017, to consider amendments to the Local Coastal Program (LCP) to add Chapter A.82 related to commercial cannabis regulations, and delete Section A.60.160. At the November 7, 2017 regular meeting, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 17-0025.

SECTION 2. The proposed zone text amendments are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements pursuant to CEQA guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that the amendments will not have the potential for any impacts on the environment. The proposed LCP amendments will prohibit all commercial cannabis uses and will not result in any direct physical change in the environment, or reasonable foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The City Council finds that the Amendments to the LCP are consistent with Policy II Coastal Locating and Planning New Development Policy - Policy II.1: Control Development within the Manhattan Beach coastal zone.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The City Council certifies that the subject amendment will be implemented in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act of 1976, as amended, and the City of Manhattan Beach Local Coastal Program.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> The City Council hereby directs the City Manager or his designee to submit the LCP amendment memorialized in Ordinance No. 17-0025 to the California Coastal Commission for certification in conformance with state law.
