- Whereas,* while society at large increasingly supports LGBTQI+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, and Intersex) equality, it is essential to acknowledge that the need for education and awareness remains vital to end discrimination and prejudice; and
- Whereas,* celebrating Pride Month influences awareness and provides support and advocacy for Manhattan Beach's LGBTQI+ community, and is an opportunity to take action and engage in dialogue to strengthen alliances, build acceptance and advance equal rights; and
- Whereas,* LGBTQI+ individuals are a vital part of all fields and professions and have had immeasurable impact to the cultural, civic and economic successes of our country; and
- Whereas,* everyone should be able to live without fear of prejudice, discrimination, violence and hatred based on ethnic, cultural, racial, religious, gender and sexual identities; and
- Whereas,* it is imperative that all people in the community, regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity, feel valued, safe, empowered, and supported by their peers, educators, neighbors and community leaders.

LGBTQI+ Pride Month


and encourage all of our residents to respect, honor and celebrate our diverse community in order to build a culture of inclusiveness and acceptance.
