ORDINANCE NO. 16-0006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH AND THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO ALLOW POLICE OFFICERS AND FIRE FIGHTERS TO SHARE THE COST OF "EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS" ON A PRE-TAX BASIS

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes an amendment to the contract between the City of Manhattan Beach and the Board of Administration, California Public Employees' Retirement System to allow police officers and the fire fighters to share the cost of "Employer Contributions" on a pre-tax basis. A copy of the amendment, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby incorporated by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of its adoption.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance.
