
BACKGROUND

- Stormwater discharges are regulated under MS4 Permit by Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board
- Beach Cities Watershed Management Program (WMP) developed by Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, Redondo Beach, Torrance, and Los Angeles County Flood Control District
- Project identified as the highest priority to reduce bacteria, trash, and debris discharges
- 28th Street drain conveys approximately 60% of City's stormwater, and has been exceeding TMDL limits

PROJECT TIMELINE

- 2015 Large-scale infiltration project identified within the Beach Cities Watershed Management Program
- 2020 CWE was hired to perform a feasibility study, which identified 26th Street parking facility as the preferred site
- 2021 Grant applications submitted to multiple agencies
- 2022 Design contract awarded to CWE
- 2024 CEQA Determination adopted by City Council
- 2025 Project P, S, & E conditionally approved by City Council





PROJECT DESIGN





PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS





- Rebuild & modernize 26th Street Lot
- New retaining walls & pervious concrete surface
- Improved circulation with revised striping
- ADA-compliant spaces & accessible pedestrian routes
- Removal of old staircases

Aug. 2027 Construction End




CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

Evaluated Impacts*	Mitigation Strategies
Noise, Dust & Debris	 Noise Barriers (if noise levels exceed thresholds) ** No Grading During High Winds** Construction BMPs required**
Road Closures, Traffic Detours, Construction Traffic	 Signage and electronic message boards 72 hour or more notification for immediate residents
Parking Lot Closure	1 year duration
Limited Street Parking	Consolidate contractor laydown area to Man. Ave. between 27 th & 26 th to reduce contractor trips


