Isabella began her scouting career as a Daisy in 2016 when she joined Girl Scout Troop 4495 and then transitioned to Brownies and Juniors, and then joined Troop 10175 as a Cadette, Senior and then to her present level as an Ambassador Girl Scout; and

Whereas,

Isabella enjoyed the many activities offered by Troop 4495 and Troop 10175, particularly selling Girl Scout cookies and boothing with her friends, working on her Bronze Award over Zoom with her troop during COVID, representing France and England at the annual World Thinking Days, collecting 3,000 books for her Silver Award project, going to Girl Scout day in Hurricane Harbor and doing the Roar and Shore campout in San Diego Safari Park. In addition to those activities, Isabella has participated in various community events including handing out American flags at the annual Salute to the Troops Concert in the Park, the annual Pumpkin Race, Pier Lighting, Skechers' Walk and the American Martyrs 5K. Isabella earned the Bronze Award in 2020 when she was in the fifth grade by sewing reusable masks and packing lunches for people served by St. James Catholic Church in Redondo Beach and she earned the Silver Award in 2023 by collecting 3,000 books from the Manhattan Beach community and helped to refurbish the First Street Elementary School's library in Los Angeles; and

for her Gold Award, Isabella developed and implemented a Women In STEM Discovery Expo program to promote STEM careers to girls in grades 8-12. She hosted two panels of nine women professionals who described their educational and STEM career paths, provided career advice and shared what they enjoy about their professions. Isabella recorded the panels and then created a how to manual and a website to host the videos so that girls who could not attend in person can still learn and be inspired to pursue a career in STEM; and

in addition to scouting activities, Isabella has demonstrated an interest and love for music and plays the violin in Mira Costa High School's Symphony Orchestra. She also enjoys baking, reading, traveling and learning French. She served on the City of Manhattan Beach's Parks and Recreation Commission as the Student Representative from 2024-2025, was an intern in Senator Ben Allen's office and currently serves as an MBEF Student Ambassador. She is also an active member of National Charity League and National Honor Society. In addition, Isabella has been actively involved in Girl Scouts and danced ballet since first grade and performed as Clara in the Nutcracker in 2023; and

Isabella understands and represents what it means to be a recipient of the Gold Award. She earned the Gold Award by meeting the Girl Scout national standards. Achievement of this national award reflects the dedication, time, leadership, creativity and effort that she has contributed to making her community better; and
