


AERIAL VIEW

- Poor Lighting
- Damaged
 - Floors
 - Doors
 - Windows
 - Railings
 - Roof

Repurposing Challenges:

- Interior Concrete/Load Bearing Walls Limit Options
- Cost Prohibitive Building Repairs










COMMUNITY INPUT

- Parks and Recreation Commission Meetings
- On-Site Community Meeting (Dec 2024)
- Online Survey with 909 Responses (Nov/Dec 2024)
 - 76% Supported Installation of a Futsal Court
 - 18% Supported Installation of a Pickleball Court



TIMELINE/BUDGET

- Public Works Facility Assessment
- Parks and Recreation Commission Review
- Public Outreach
- City Council Work Plan Meeting / Manhattan Beach Library Community Needs Assessment
- Parks Master Plan Discussion
- Interim Strategy Proposed
- \$142,000 Project Budget (CIP and Measure A Grant)
- If approved, project complete in Fiscal Year 2025-2026
