

BACKGROUND

- Feb. 2024: City Council 2nd status update report
 - Preferred program vision (Conceptual Plan)
 - Sidewalk widening
 - Parking reconfiguration
 - Outdoor dining and public flex space identification













Factors Considered:

- 1. Relatively flat terrain
- 2. Multiple businesses
- 3. Continuous widening of entire block
- 4. No net loss of street parking
- 5. Northbound street lane alignment





Work Scope:

- Install modular system to widen sidewalk by 8 ft
- Restripe roadway
- Remove/relocate parking meters and reconfigure parking spaces
- ·Level sidewalk area
- Build ADA transition ramp







Task Force Recommendations

- Allow one-year of trial period
- Incorporate QR code onsite to receive feedback
- Implement proposed sidewalk dining regulations
- Consider the material of transition ramp







- Coastal Development

 Effort is supported by

- Estimated at \$136,605
 - Modular system: \$78,450
 - Public Works: \$58,155(Incl. routine maintenance)
