A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL OPPOSING THE RENAMING OF ARTESIA BOULEVARD TO REDONDO BEACH BOULEVARD WITHIN THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, Section 34091.1 of the Government Code and Section 5026 of the Streets and Highways Code authorize the legislative body of a City to adopt or change the name of a City street by adoption of a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manhattan Beach owns half of Artesia Boulevard and the City of Redondo Beach owns the other half; and

WHEREAS, a street name change for only one side of the street would be confusing to the public in general.

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby opposes the renaming of Artesia Boulevard to Redondo Beach Boulevard within the City of Manhattan Beach city limits.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
