# Background

City is transitioning from aging single-space meters to modern pay-by-plate and mobile payment

Project implements the Parking Management Strategies adopted in November 2025

Direction to move forward with Technology Roadmap approved by City Council in April 2025



# Fiscal Impact

\$2.9 million currently budgeted in CIP

NTE Amount of \$2.42M includes one-time capital purchase of \$895,410



# Fiscal Impact – Ongoing Costs

## Year 1 Fees

\$247,980 for both  
Pay Stations and  
Mobile Payment

## Annual Fees Years 2 - 5

- \$289,980 for both  
Pay Stations and  
Mobile Payment

## Operational Costs

\$25,000/yr



# Procurement Process

RFP issued August 2025 through OpenGov

Eight proposals received, one disqualified

Multi-department evaluation committee established in advance

Written proposals, interviews, demonstrations, and references evaluated

The committee scored ParkMobile the highest for both solutions



# Agreement Overview



Three-year agreement for pay stations and mobile payment services



Includes purchase, installation, and ongoing operation



Supports both kiosk and mobile payment options



Contract includes two optional one-year extensions

# Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council:

- 1) Adopt Resolution No. 26-0017 awarding a three-year agreement with ParkMobile, LLC, for the purchase, installation, and operation of parking pay stations and mobile parking payment system services in an amount not to exceed \$2,428,310.
- 2) Authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement and any necessary amendments, including exercising up to two additional one-year extensions if deemed in the City's best interest.
