

RESOLUTION NO. 26-0023

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL DETERMINING A CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION FROM THE CEQA GUIDELINES FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROJECT 602745-24 CYCLE 4 ADA CURB RAMPS PROJECT; APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS; AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO OPPENHEIMER NATIONAL; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANGER TO APPROVE ADDITIONAL WORK, IF NECESSARY

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council has reviewed the plans and specifications for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Project 602745-24 Cycle 4 ADA Curb Ramps Project (“Project”) and hereby finds the Project categorically exempt from applicable provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) (the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; including existing highways, streets, or sidewalks) which applies to these sidewalk curb ramps.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves the plans and specifications for the Project.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby approves that certain agreement (“Agreement”) between the City of Manhattan Beach (“City”) and Oppenheimer National (“Contractor”), dated March 17, 2026, for the Project, in the amount of \$116,996.56.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute the Agreement and further authorizes the City Manager and/or his or her designee to pay Contractor up to an additional \$24,000 for additional work, if necessary.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and thenceforth and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
