

RESOLUTION NO. 14-0046

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS NOS. 14-0040, 14-0041, AND 14-0042 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING A TERM LIMITS MEASURE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON MARCH 3, 2015

RECITALS

1. On June 3, 2014, the Manhattan Beach City Council adopted Resolutions 14-0040, 14-0041, and 14-0042 to submit to the voters at a special election to be consolidated with the November 4, 2014 election a proposed term limits measure for elected officials.
2. The City Council wants to rescind the resolutions for the purpose of submitting the term limits measure to the voters at the general municipal election date of March 3, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolutions Nos. 14-0040, 14-0041, and 14-0042 related to calling a special election on November 4, 2014 for a term limits measure are hereby rescinded and shall have no further force or effect.

Section 2. In accordance with applicable law, the City Council will duly adopt all necessary resolutions to call an election for the general municipal election to be held on March 3, 2015, to submit to the voters the following question:

Shall an ordinance be adopted which prohibits any member of the city council and the city treasurer from holding the same office for more than two terms?	YES

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
