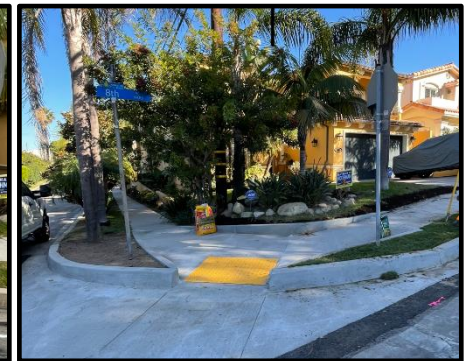

# AGENDA ACTION ITEMS

- City Council Consideration to:
  - Conducting Public Hearing per CDBG regulations
  - Adopting Resolution approving 2024-2025 CDBG Program.
  - Authorizing use of CDBG funds of approximately \$213,772.
  - Construction of 10 – 15 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps.



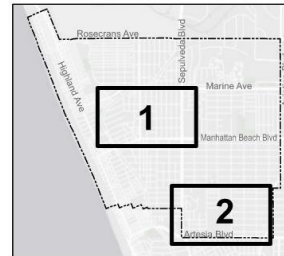
# WHAT IS CDBG PROGRAM?

- Administered by Los Angeles County Development Authority.
- Benefits low- and moderate- income residents.
- Prevents neighborhood deterioration.
- Meets urgent community development needs.
- Improves mobility and accessibility for elderly and disabled.

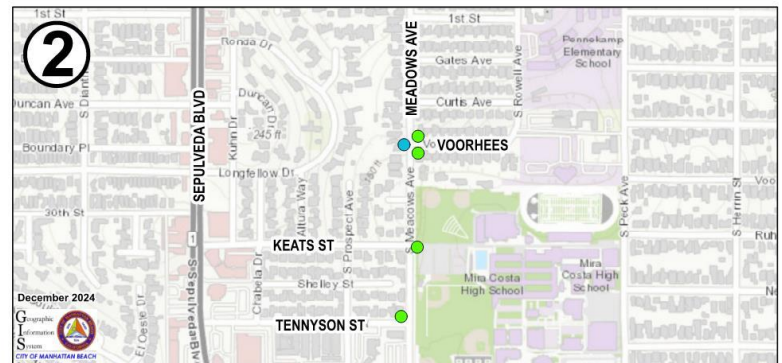
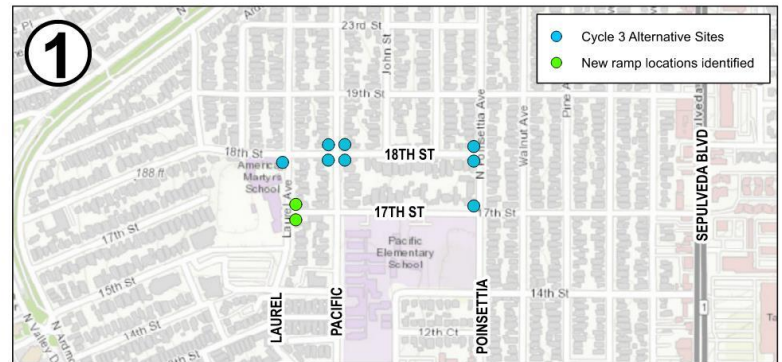


# CDBG CYCLE 4 CURB RAMP SCOPE

- Construct approximately 10-15 ADA curb ramps.
- Improve paths of travel for elderly and disabled.
- Primarily in residential areas; adjacent to schools.
- Approximately 96 ADA ramps constructed since 2017.

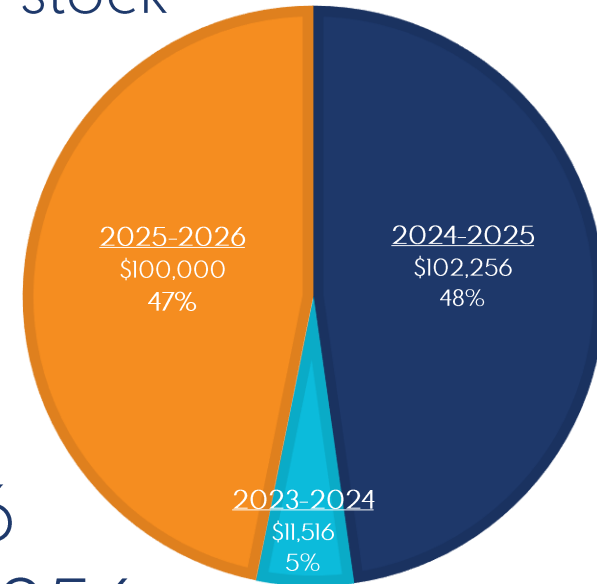


City of Manhattan Beach

# CDBG FUNDING

- CDBG annual funding based on:
  - Poverty, overcrowding & aged housing stock
  - County CDBG Program participants
  - Census population counts



- City's CDBG Funding:
  - 2023-2024 CDBG Funds - \$11,516
  - 2024-2025 CDBG Funds - \$102,256
  - **2025-2026 CDBG Funds - \$100,000**
  - **\$213,772 in total CDBG Funds**



# STAFF RECOMMENDATION



Staff recommends that the City Council:

- A. City Council conduct a Public Hearing
- B. Adopt Resolution No. 25-0010 authorizing the use of Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025 CDBG funds in the amount of \$113,772 to implement the construction of ADA compliant curb ramps. In addition, City of Manhattan Beach may add its 2025-2026 CDBG allocation, estimated at \$100,000, to increase the project budget to \$213,772.
- C. This proposed project is consistent with the City's 5-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Plan.
