CITY INITIATIVE MEASURES ESTABLISHING LOCAL REGULATION & TAXATION



CITIZEN-INITIATIVE

- Repeals the City's existing prohibition;
- Requires the City to issue permits to three cannabis retailers in certain commercial districts with buffer zones.
- Directs the City Manager to adopt an application process.
- Establishes a point system for evaluating and ranking applicants.
- Does not impose a City tax on cannabis.



COUNCIL DIRECTION

To return with:

- A measure banning cannabis which would reaffirm the ordinances previously adopted by the City Council that prohibit the commercial sale of cannabis in the City.
- A Measure which would establish a City commercial cannabis tax and regulations.



CITY MEASURE: MAINTAINING BAN

For consideration at next City Council meeting:

- Established in 2017 with the passage of two ordinances banning the sale of commercial cannabis.
- Maintains the ban.
- If it passes, and receives more votes than the citizen initiative, it prevails.
- Cannot be amend or repealed unless it is sent back to the voters.
