



- March June, 2023 RFP posted, submissions compiled/vetted, APPC/Cultural Arts Commission (CAC) recommend 8 semifinalists
- <u>July 18, 2023</u> City Council approve 5 semifinalists
- <u>August October, 2023</u> Contracts signed, town hall meeting, maquettes created, APPC/CAC review/recommend finalist
- November 21, 2023 City Council approve finalist, award bid
- <u>December 2023 April 2025</u> contract administered, artwork created, permits/surveys/studies completed, artwork installed
- Spring 2025 Artwork unveiling
