ORDINANCE NO. 14-0004

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH AMENDING SECTION 5.88.010 OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE TO APPLY THE CITY'S PROHIBITION AGAINST PLASTIC CARRY-OUT BAGS TO RESTAURANTS

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.88.010(A) of Chapter 5.88 of Title 5 of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended with respect to the definition of "Vendor" as follows, with all other definitions to remain unchanged:

"Vendor" means any store, shop, restaurant, sales outlet, mobile food vendor, pushcart, or other commercial establishment located within or doing business within the City of Manhattan Beach, which provides perishable or nonperishable goods."

- <u>Section 2</u>. Section 5.88.010(B) of Chapter 5.88 of Title 5 of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to remove subsection (6) from that section.
- Section 3. CEQA Finding. The City Council hereby finds that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption of this Ordinance will have a significant effect on the environment. It is therefore exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review pursuant to 14 California Code of Regulations Section 15061(b)(3).
- <u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published within fifteen (15) days after its passage, in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the 31st day after its passage.
