# **Background Info -Pier Complex**



- Pier structure constructed in 1920
- Roundhouse Building
  - Constructed in 1922
  - Rebuilt in 1991
  - Rehabilitated in 2002
- In 1988, the City entered into an operating agreement with the State in which the City assumed maintenance responsibilities of the Pier Complex
- Parking Revenues fund maintenance and operations of the Pier Complex

## Facility Assessment Study & Foundation Grant for Aquarium



- 2013 Citywide Facility Assessment Study (FSA) Pier and Roundhouse included
  - FSA indicates that significant work is required at these facilities
- April 2015 Aquarium Funding
  - Nonzero\architecture design consultant retained for architectural and engineering services for Pier, Roundhouse and Comfort Station building
  - Harrison Greenberg Foundation pledges grant to fund renovation of aquarium inside Roundhouse
- July, 2016 Tri-Party Cooperative Agreement for the Roundhouse Aquarium Renovation Project
  - (City, Harrison Greenberg Foundation and Oceanographic Teaching Stations)

### City Scope of Work – Pier and Roundhouse Building



- Repair stucco and paint exterior of Roundhouse (anti-graffiti coating)
- Replace all exterior doors, shutters and hardware
- Repair roofing and replace Cupola on the Roundhouse
- Replace potable water, fire protection and sewer pipelines
- Replace wiring for electrical power utility
- Install low voltage services for security and emergency telephone system on the Pier
- Install Life Ring Cabinet on the Pier
- Install gutters and downspouts (matching fascia color)
- Install fish cleaning stations at west end of pier

### Tri-Party Scope of Work – Roundhouse Aquarium



- Complete interior remodel and reconfigure of aquarium, concession space and men's & women's restrooms
- Enhance the architecture, exhibit designs and provide interactive elements
- Provide smaller, temporary aquarium at base of pier during construction
- Provide temporary housing at other nearby aquaria for remaining aquarium animals

- Design Contract with Cambridge Seven Associates for Roundhouse Aquarium Design Services Awarded February 21, 2017
- Amendment No. 2 with Nonzero\architecture for Pier and Roundhouse exterior improvements design services approved on February 21, 2017
- Design Workshop conducted March 7-9, 2017
- Pier & Roundhouse Exterior Improvements design kickoff meeting March 21, 2017

































































































#### **Preliminary Design Construction Phasing Temporary Aquarium**

## **Proposed Project Timeline**



- Preliminary Design and Entitlements: March July, 2017
- Preparation of Construction Documents for Bidding: July – September, 2017
- Coastal Commission Hearing for Coastal Development Permit: June – September (Application Submitted April 24, 2017)
- Bidding Phase: September October, 2017
- Establish Temporary Facilities and Aquarium Move-Out: November – December, 2017
- Construction Phase: January May, 2018
- Project Complete: June, 2018
