On April 30th, 2016 at approximately 0053 hours, Officer Gibbons and Officer Manqueros responded to 11th Street and Manhattan Avenue regarding a victim who

was hunched over and bleeding from his head; and

When the officers arrived, they observed that the victim was unconscious and not

breathing. The officers acted immediately; and

In an effort to save the victim's life, Officer Gibbons and Manqueros initiated CPR. Both officers administered chest compressions until the Manhattan Beach Fire

Department personnel transported the victim to Little Company of Mary Hospital

for further medical treatment; and

The medical staff that aided the victim believed he suffered a heart attack prior to

the officers' arrival. The victim survived for approximately one week and then

unfortunately passed away; and

The swift actions taken by Officer Gibbons and Manqueros allowed the family of

the victim to be with him for the final week of his life. The family has since thanked

the officers for their life-saving efforts; and

Officer David Gibbons and Officer Teresa Manqueros will receive the Life Saving

Award at the South Bay Police and Fire Medal of Valor Luncheon on May 25, 2017 and we proudly join his colleagues, family, and friends in recognizing him for this

special honor.
