## RESOLUTION NO. 17-0095

## A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL ELECTING TO BECOME SUBJECT TO THE UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT

## **RECITALS**

A. Local agencies must competitively bid all public projects (as defined by California Public Contract Code Section 20161) in excess of \$5,000 in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Public Contract Code, commencing with Section 20160.

B Prior to the enactment of the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act ("Act"), a uniform cost accounting standard was unavailable for construction work performed or contracted by or for local public agencies.

C. Pursuant to the Act, the Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission, in conjunction with the State Controller, has established uniform public construction cost accounting procedures for implementation by local public agencies electing to be governed by the provisions of the Act in performing or contracting for construction of public projects.

D. The City Council hereby determines that it is in the best interests of the City to be subject to the provisions of the Act. The benefits to the City include, but are not limited to, availability of alternate bidding procedures allowing the City to perform work costing up to and including \$45,000, as may be revised, by force account, and to let contracts by informal procedures for public projects costing up to and including \$175,000, as may be revised, or more under specified circumstances.

E. California Public Contract Code Section 22030 provides that any city that wishes to avail itself of the alternative procedures for bidding and contracting for public projects must elect, by resolution, to become subject to the uniform construction cost accounting procedures set forth in the Public Contract Code and must notify the State Controller of its election.

F. California Public Contract Code Section 22034 requires each public agency that elects to become subject to the uniform construction cost accounting procedures to enact an informal bidding ordinance that complies with the requirements set forth in Section 22034.

G. All legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that all of the facts set forth in the foregoing Recitals are true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** Pursuant to the authority set forth in the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act, California Public Contract Code Section 22000, *et seq.*, the City of Manhattan

Beach hereby elects to be subject to the uniform public construction cost accounting procedures set forth in the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act and to the policies and procedures manual and cost accounting review procedures established thereunder, as each may be amended from time to time.

**SECTION 3.** The City Clerk shall notify the State Controller of the City's election pursuant to Section 2, above. The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately.
