## Residential Curbside Carts

Type of Residential Cart	Residential Cart Count
Trash (Gray)	
Recycling (Blue)	12,000+
Organics – yard/food (Green)	



67% residents use a 64 gallon trash cart



25% residents use a 35 gallon trash cart




5% residents use a 96 gallon trash cart




## Residential Services At-a-Glance: Curbside Trash (gray cart)





#### Residential Services At-a-Glance: Curbside Recycling (blue cart)












# Residential Food Waste Program

- Question: Are there different dedicated carts (available for food waste collection) & how do other cities handle residential food waste other than plastic bags?
- If there were a dedicated cart to handle food waste, is there a different seal to handle odor and sanitary issues that a city may experience around town (especially if there is a higher participation rate)?

## Residential Food Waste Program




The City owns the residential curbside carts, and can require a specific type of cart in the next franchise agreement.

"Latch Lid" Carts




"Gravity Lock Lid" Carts
