

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH**  
**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**  
**FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019**

The public is invited to review the **City of Manhattan Beach's** proposed revision to the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan which identifies projected use of funds for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This revision reports on substantial changes to the 2018-2019 Action Plan. The proposed revision is the cancellation of FY 2018-2019 CDBG Project "Installation of ADA Access Ramps, Cycle 3" (601962-18) in the amount of \$106,801 and, instead, reprogram funds from this cancelled project to a new, proposed FY 2018-2019 CDBG project entitled, "Manhattan Senior Villas Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Pathway Project".

**Project Title: Manhattan Senior Villas Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)**  
**Pathway Project**

**CDBG FY 2018-2019 Funding Allocation:                      \$106,801.00**

This new project will remove architectural and/or material barriers for elderly and/or severely disabled persons and create a safe and continuous pedestrian path of travel beginning at Parkview Avenue to the terminus of the Manhattan Senior Villas. Specifically, the proposed project will remove an existing non-compliant dirt and uneven gravel pathway and replace with approximately 250 linear feet of an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant concrete pathway. The project includes grading and compaction, installation of ADA-compliant perimeter railing, ADA-compliant directional signage, installation of an ADA-compliant curb ramp and gutter, 1,500 square feet of ADA-compliant pathway striping and ADA parking lot stall striping.

The City's FY 2019-2020 and FY 2020-2021 CDBG funds of approximately \$213,602 will also be committed to this project for a total CDBG project allocation of approximately \$320,403. CDBG funds will be used for construction management, labor compliance, and capital outlay costs.
