

RESOLUTION NO. 18-0110

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE CANCELLATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROJECT NUMBER 601962-18, ENTITLED, "INSTALLATION OF ADA ACCESS RAMPS – CYCLE 3" AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF THE CDBG FUNDING AMOUNT OF \$106,801 INTO A NEW FY 2018-2019 CDBG PROJECT ENTITLED, "MANHATTAN SENIOR VILLAS AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) PATHWAY PROJECT"

WHEREAS, on August 22, 1974, the President of the United States signed into law the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Act); and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of Title 1 of the Act are the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, the City receives an allocation of federal Community Development Block Grant funds as a participating city under the County of Los Angeles Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program to further the attainment of these goals; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed, approved and adopted Resolution 18-0012 on January 16, 2018 approving the CDBG funding allocation for the 2018-2019 Program Year; and

WHEREAS, the Installation of ADA Access Ramps – Cycle 3 for 15 locations citywide was approved for funding; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and in response to the needs of senior adults and disabled residents of the City and the Manhattan Villas residential community, staff recommends that FY 2018-2019 CDBG Project 601962-18, Installation of ADA Access Ramps – Cycle 3 be cancelled, and the revised estimated funding allocation amount of \$106,801 be appropriated to the new FY 2018-2019 CDBG Project entitled, Manhattan Senior Villas Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Pathway Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a public hearing, with the required prior noticing to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed cancellation of CDBG Project 601962-18, Installation of ADA Access Ramps – Cycle 3, and the re-appropriation of that project's CDBG funds totaling \$106,801 into the Manhattan Senior Villas Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Pathway Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDER AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the cancellation of CDBG Project 601962-18, Installation of ADA Access Ramps – Cycle 3 and instruct staff to submit the necessary documentation and a copy of this Resolution to the Los Angeles County Community Development Commission.

SECTION 2. The City Council approves the re-appropriation of that project's CDBG funds estimated at \$106,801 into the Manhattan Senior Villas Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Pathway Project.

SECTION 3. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute all necessary contracts and agreements with the Los Angeles County Community Development Commission, in order complete the proposed CDBG Program changes which may be reviewed as necessary by the City Attorney.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and thenceforth and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
