

RESOLUTION NO. 19-0011

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL
AMENDING THE FINES AND PENALTIES FOR
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATIONS ASSESSED IN CONNECTION
WITH ILLEGAL TRANSIENT USES PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 53069.4

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY DECLARE, FIND,
DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Government Code Section 53069.4(a)(1), the City Council may by ordinance make any violation of any ordinance enacted by the local agency subject to an administrative fine or penalty. On September 6, 2016, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 16-0018, which makes any violation of the Municipal Code or any ordinance enacted by the City subject to an administrative fine or penalty.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 16-0018 provides that the amount of the fine associated with the administrative citation will be assessed according to a schedule of fines adopted by the City Council.

SECTION 3. On January 15, 2019, the City Council held a duly notice public hearing to consider regulations, fees and penalties for the renting of residential property for less than 30 days.

SECTION 4. Based upon the foregoing, the City Council hereby adopts a fine of \$1,000 for any violation of Municipal Code Chapter 4.88.

SECTION 5. The adoption of this Resolution approves and sets forth a procedure for establishing fines and penalties for administrative citations and is, therefore, exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Sections 21080 et seq.) pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8)(A).

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
