

RESOLUTION NO. 19-0039

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY
COUNCIL ADOPTING THE LOCAL HAZARDS
MITIGATION PLAN, APRIL 2018

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS
FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS the City of Manhattan Beach recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of Manhattan Beach; and

WHEREAS the City of Manhattan Beach has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Local Hazards Mitigation Plan, April 2018, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS Local Hazards Mitigation Plan, April 2018 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Manhattan Beach from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the City of Manhattan Beach demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Local Hazards Mitigation Plan, April 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA THAT:

SECTION 1. In accordance with (local rule for adopting resolutions), the City of Manhattan Beach City Council hereby Adopts Resolution No. 19-0039 the Local Hazards Mitigation Plan, April 2018.

SECTION 2. The Council hereby directs the City Manager or his designee to submit the Plan to the State Office of Emergency Services for final approval.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.
