After an extensive review process conducted by the Home For Good Funders Collaborative, your city has been selected for the following partially award(s):

• \$330,665 selected for partial award under Priority Area 2: Enhance County service systems for those experiencing or at-risk of homelessness

Not all components of your original request were recommended to be funded at this stage:

- \$30,000 is <u>not</u> eligible for resubmission under Priority Area 2: Enhance County service systems for those experiencing or at-risk of homelessness. Training will not be considered for resubmission because this component will be provided centrally and will leverage existing training resources.
