AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH AND GENERAL PUMP COMPANY

This First Amendment ("Amendment No. 1") to that certain agreement by and between the City of Manhattan Beach, a California municipal corporation ("City") and General Pump Company, Inc., a California corporation ("Consultant") (collectively, the "Parties") is hereby entered into as of March 18, 2020 ("Effective Date").

RECITALS

- A. On October 1, 2019, the City and Contractor entered into an agreement for services for the Contractor to provide repairs on Booster Pump No. 4 ("Agreement");
- B. The Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to modify the Scope of Services, and to increase the Maximum Compensation amount to provide compensation for the additional services, and extend the Completion Date for the Work (as those terms are defined in the Agreement).
- NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the Parties' performance of the promises, covenants, and conditions stated herein, the Parties hereby agree as follows:
- <u>Section 1.</u> Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby revised to change the Completion Date to June 1, 2020.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Section 5 of the Agreement is hereby revised to increase the Maximum Compensation amount by \$21,719, for a new Maximum Compensation of \$71,603.
- <u>Section 3.</u> "Exhibit A Scope of Work and Fee Schedule" of the Agreement is hereby replaced by the "Exhibit A Updated Scope of Work and Fee Schedule" attached to this Amendment.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Except as specifically amended by this Amendment No. 1, all other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
