## RESOLUTION NO. 20-0127

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF ORDINANCE NO. 20-0010 TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION TO AMEND THE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM (LCP) CHAPTER 7.36 – PRIVATE USE OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY OF TITLE 7

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Council conducted a duly noticed public meeting pursuant to applicable law on July 7, 2020 to consider amendments to Section A.52.110 of the Local Coastal Program (LCP) to refine standards pertaining to the private use of the public right-of-way. At the July 20, 2020 regular meeting, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20-0010.

SECTION 2. The previously adopted amendments are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements pursuant to CEQA guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that the amendments will not have the potential for any impacts on the environment. The adoption of this transmittal resolution is not a "Project" as defined under Section 15378 of the State CEQA Guidelines; therefore, pursuant to Section 15060(c)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines the adoption of this Resolution is not subject to CEQA.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. The City Council finds that the Amendments to the LCP are consistent with Policy II.1 of the LCP Policies and Implementation Measures which states "Control development within the Manhattan Beach Coastal Zone".

SECTION 4. The City Council certifies that the subject amendment will be implemented in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act of 1976, as amended, and the City of Manhattan Beach Local Coastal Program.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. The City Council hereby directs staff to submit Ordinance No. 20-0010 amending Chapter 7.36 of the LCP to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
