AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH AND ALL CITY MANAGEMENT SERVICES, INC.

This First Amendment ("Amendment No. 1") to that certain agreement by and between the City of Manhattan Beach, a California municipal corporation ("City") and All City Management Services, Inc., a California corporation ("Consultant") (collectively, the "Parties") is hereby entered into as of November 17, 2020 ("Effective Date").

RECITALS

A. On August 7, 2017, the City and Consultant entered into an agreement for professional services for the Consultant to provide crossing guard services ("Agreement");

B. The Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to extend the term by two years and document the increase to the Maximum Compensation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the Parties' performance of the promises, covenants, and conditions stated herein, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby revised to extend the term of the Agreement through August 7, 2022, unless sooner terminated as provided in Section 12 of the Agreement.

<u>Section 2.</u> Section 3.A of the Agreement is hereby revised to increase the Maximum Compensation amount by \$600,000 for a new Maximum Compensation of \$ 1,418,175 to cover two additional years of service and anticipated increases to minimum wage.

<u>Section 3.</u> Exhibit B (Fee Schedule) of the Agreement is hereby replaced by the Fee Schedule attached to this Amendment increasing the hourly rates, in line with anticipated minimum wage increases.

<u>Section 4.</u> Except as specifically amended by this Amendment No. 1, all other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
