

URGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 21-0004-U

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH REPEALING SECTION 14.36.070 OF CHAPTER 14.36 OF TITLE 14 OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE, DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF, AND MAKING A DETERMINATION OF EXEMPTION UNDER CEQA

THE MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby repeals Manhattan Beach Municipal Code (MBMC) Section 14.36.070 in its entirety.

SECTION 2. CEQA FINDING. This Ordinance is exempt from the environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 3. INTERNAL CONSISTENCY. Any provisions of the Municipal Code, or any other resolution or ordinance of the City, to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and the City Clerk shall make any necessary changes to the Municipal Code for internal consistency.

SECTION 4. CERTIFICATION. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be published within 15 days after its passage, in accordance with Government Code Section 36933.

SECTION 5. URGENCY. MBMC Section 14.36.070 is inconsistent with MBMC Chapter 10.72, the City's Sign Code. Therefore, the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this Ordinance be enacted as an urgency ordinance pursuant to Government Code Section 36937(b) and that it take effect immediately upon adoption pursuant to Government Code Section 36934, and its urgency is hereby declared.
