CATALINA CLASSIC SCULPTURE

- Race began in 1955 and has run consecutively since 1982
- SBBC proposed a statue on July 11th, 2018
- CAC approved in concept on October 15, 2018
- After multiple revisions, APPC and CAC approved, returning to CC for final direction
- Public notice by staff and public outreach by SBBC



CATALINA CLASSIC SCULPTURE

- Original design consisted of one person with a board
- After conversations with previous staff, design was significantly expanded to include a plaza, new bicycle rack, and ADA improvements
- Council directed SBBC to truncate design and reduce scope of work
- Three versions of diminishing size were brought to APPC
- Final design has the smallest footprint and sits directly in the sand



CATALINA CLASSIC SCULPTURE

- Final proposal consists of statue directly in the sand
- 3 realistic figures, 17.5' tall
- Conforms to ADA requirements
- Need to relocate 1 palm tree
- Need to relocate ADA parking spot
- No significant impact on special events and vehicle access
- Outreach to nearby residents
- Possible view obstruction
- City commits to ongoing maintenance



CONCLUSION

- No financial commitment from City other than regular maintenance
- Obstruction to view
- Risk Management and ADA compliant
- Niche event attracting a limited following
- If approved, give City Manager signing authority for MOU
